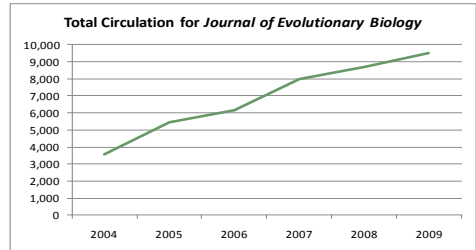


## Circulation

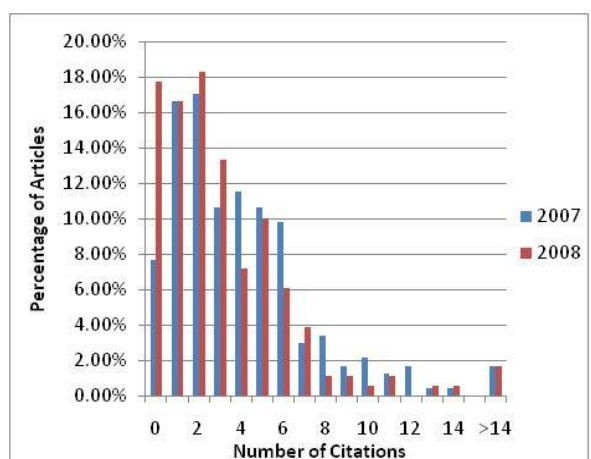
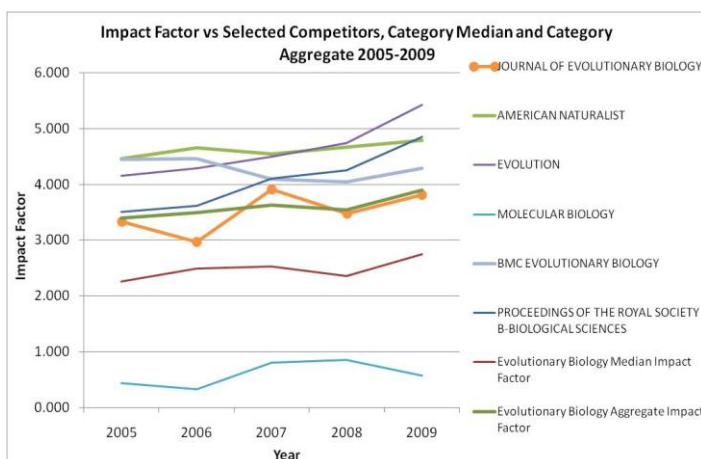

## Manuscript categories

*JEB* publishes ordinary Research Articles (typically 6-10 printed pages), Short Communications (typically 3-5 pages; results and discussion may be combined), Review Articles (also short 'Mini Reviews') and Target Reviews. The latter are typically commissioned and authors should contact the Reviews Editor before submission.

## Production times

- In 2009, *JEB* moved to a monthly publication model, with 12 online issues and 6-bimonthly combined print issues. This model has proved successful and allows for greater exposure of the journal, including 12 photographic journal covers that are featured in our online [Cover Gallery](#)
- *JEB* published more than 2,500 pages in 2009
- Since 2008 the average Early View publication time for each year has been less than 30 working days
- Times to average online issue and print issue publication in 2010 are 51 and 56 working days, respectively
