

AUTHOR CHECKLIST:

1. Does the cover letter indicate that the material, in whole or part, has not been previously published and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere?
2. Do all authors satisfy all three criteria as defined below?
 - a. Have made significant scientific contribution to the work:
This includes substantial contribution to the conception, design, acquisition of data, data analysis, or interpretation of data.
 - b. Are familiar with the content:
This includes drafting or revising the manuscript critically for important intellectual content.
 - c. Are willing to take responsibility for the completeness and accuracy of the content:
This includes the final approval of the manuscript.

Individuals who satisfy only 1 or 2 of the above 3 criteria should be recognized in the Acknowledgments section of the manuscript. For questions regarding authorship please refer to: <http://www.icmje.org>
3. Have all authors declared all potential conflicts of interest relating to the manuscript content, prepa-

ration, and funding?

This includes: All financial interests in the manuscript; acknowledgment of all funding support; disclosure of affiliations or financial involvement with an entity having financial interest or conflict relating to the material presented in the manuscript. These relationships include, but are not limited to, employment, consultancy, honoraria, stock ownership, grant support, paid expert testimony, patents, royalties, and payments for participation in manuscript preparation.

5. Is the Exclusive License Form (ELF) completed?
