We are looking for an Editor to lead a team of highly committed Associate Editors and Editorial Board Members for this highly successful journal focused on cancer care.

The *European Journal of Cancer Care* is a leading research journal which provides a medium for communicating comprehensive, multi-professional cancer care across Europe and internationally. It publishes peer-reviewed papers, reviews, reports, features and news, and provides a means of recording lively debate and exchange of ideas. It publishes papers from health professionals working in the fields of epidemiology and health policy of cancer, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, primary, secondary and tertiary care, rehabilitation, supportive care and palliative care.

The current Editor, Pat Webb, has given many years' excellent service to the Journal and has firmly established the Journal within the cancer care arena. Because of the Journal's success and the subsequent increase in the day-to-day workload, there is a need to widen the editorial team. We are looking for an Editor who is involved in the care of cancer patients as part of a multidisciplinary team or actively researching in this area of care. The Editor's area of practice and/or research could be from one of any of the disciplines involved in cancer care. The ideal candidate will be recognised internationally. The four main functions within this role are: Strategic Management, Editorial Team Management, Manuscript Management and Journal Promotion. The new Editor will assume editorial control and strategic direction for the Journal in consultation with the Publisher, Editor-in-Chief, Associate Editors and Editorial Board. Upon the new Editor's appointment, Pat will become Editor-in Chief and looks forward to working with the new Editor whilst he or she becomes familiar with the journal.

The ideal person must possess the following skills:

- PhD OR significant research experience with good track record of academic publications
- Excellent written and verbal communication
- Sound scientific judgement
- Leadership qualities
- Excellent knowledge of research frontiers in cancer care (internationally)
- Ability to work to tight deadlines.
- Commercial awareness (marketing and advertising)
- Reliable and regular email contact and be able to work online

Applicants should note that this position requires a minimum of five hours work each week with the possibility of additional days required for meetings and conferences. In light of this an honorarium is granted, as well as an allowance for expenses. There is in-house editorial administration provided by the Publisher. There is no restriction on where the Editor is based geographically. We would like the new Editor to be in place by 1st September 2008. Please note that more than one new Editor may be appointed.

Applications should include a curriculum vitae, a short assessment of the strengths and weaknesses of the *European Journal of Cancer Care* internationally and within Europe, and an outline of your vision for this Journal and how you would like to see it develop in the future.
