Copyright Transfer Agreement	Online submission	Corresponding authors are required to download and complete the Copyright Transfer Agreement. Title	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	Concise and informative title (maximum 15 words); no trademarks, no acronyms Optimising titles for search engines— http://authorservices.wiley.com/bauthor/seo.asp	<input type="checkbox"/>
Short title	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	Running head not exceeding 50 characters	<input type="checkbox"/>
Authors	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	Name (initials followed by surname), department, institution and country for all authors.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Corresponding author	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	Name, address, telephone number and email address	<input type="checkbox"/>

Funding sources	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	State sources of funding for the research and its publication, or for the publication, including a short description of the involvement of the funder in study design, data collection, data analysis, manuscript preparation and/or publication decisions. Conflicts of interest	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	Disclose all potential conflicts of interest, including all relevant financial interests (e.g., employment, significant share ownership, patent rights, consultancy, research funding) in any company or organisation that might benefit from the publication. If none, please state “None declared”	<input type="checkbox"/>
What’s known/what’s new statements	Manuscript (title page) & online submission	For review articles, original articles and short communications, please answer the following questions in 2 or 3 bulleted statements (limit of 70 words). Please use the following two headlines: “What’s already known about this topic?”; “What does this study add?”	<input type="checkbox"/>
Abstract	Manuscript & online submission	Authors submitting original articles should note that the structured abstracts are required (maximum 250 words). Structured abstracts should adopt the format: Background, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions. Review articles and short communications require abstracts (maximum 250 words) but they need not be structured Optimising abstracts for search engines— http://authorservices.wiley.com/bauthor/seo.asp	<input type="checkbox"/>
Word count	Manuscript	Abstracts should not exceed 250 words. Introductions should not exceed 500 words. Discussions (including Conclusions) should not exceed 1500 words	<input type="checkbox"/>
Author contributions	Manuscript & online submission	Authors are required to include a statement of responsibility in their manuscript that specifies the contribution of every author. Please state that all authors discussed the results and commented on the manuscript. Corresponding authors will be required to check a box confirming authorship criteria during the online submission All listed authors should meet ICMJE authorship criteria and nobody who qualifies for authorship should be excluded. Authorship credit should be based on 1) substantial contributions to conception and design, acquisition of data, or analysis and interpretation of data; 2) drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and 3) final approval of the version to be published. Authors should meet conditions 1, 2, and 3.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Reviewers	Online submission	Corresponding authors are required to supply the names of two preferred reviewers; this will facilitate the efficient and swift review of manuscripts	<input type="checkbox"/>
Supplementary material	Online submission	Optional. <i>EJP</i> encourages the submission of large tables, underlying datasets, appendices, movie files, etc. as “online only files”	
Online Open	Post submission	Optional. Online Open is available to authors of articles who wish to make their article available to non-subscribers on publication, or whose funding agency requires grantees to archive the final version of their article.
