Prior Publication	Online submission system	You will be asked during online submission to confirm that the submitted work is not	
		published, in press or currently being considered for publication elsewhere.	
		(Abstracts, presentations at scientific meetings and clinical trial data posting should be	
		indicated in Cover Letter. Publication of abstracts, presentations at scientific meetings and	
		subsequent press coverage will not jeopardise full publication in IJCP. Posting of clinical trials	
		results in databases [data without interpretation, discussion, context or full conclusions in the	
		form of tables and text to describe data/information where this is not easily presented in	
		tabular form] prior to submission to IJCP will not jeopardize full peer reviewed publication in	
		IJCP.)
