A new editorial position has been created within the editorial team of *Journal of Clinical Nursing (JCN)*. The *JCN* is an international, peer reviewed, scientific journal that seeks to promote the development and exchange of knowledge that is directly relevant to all spheres of nursing and midwifery practice. The primary aim is to promote a high standard of clinically related scholarship which supports the practice and discipline of nursing. *JCN* publishes high quality papers on issues related to clinical nursing, regardless of where care is provided. This includes - but is not limited to - ambulatory care, community care, family care, home, hospital, practice, primary and secondary, and public health. The Reviews Editor will join the Journal's management team, comprising of the Editor-in-Chief and 2 Editors and 5 Associate Editors, and contribute to the strategic development of the journal.

The ideal person would possess the following:

- PhD OR significant research experience with good track record of academic publications
- International profile
- Excellent written and verbal communication
- Sound scientific judgment
- Excellent knowledge of research frontiers in nursing (internationally)
- Reliable and regular email contact and be able to work online

The main role of the Review Editor will be to take on responsibility for the Review papers submitted to and published in the Journal. A detailed job description is available upon request. Applicants should note that this position requires a minimum of five hours work each week with additional days required for meetings and conferences. In light of this a modest honorarium is granted. There is in-house editorial administration provided by the Publisher. There is no restriction on where the Editor is based geographically.

Applications should include a curriculum vitae, a short assessment of the strengths and weaknesses of the *Journal of Clinical Nursing*, and an outline of your vision for the Review section of this Journal and how you would like to see it develop in the future.
