



Call for Manuscripts on Plant Adaptation

To celebrate the bicentennial of Darwin's birth and the sesquicentennial of the publication of *The Origin of Species*, *New Phytologist* will publish a special issue devoted to plant adaptation. This issue will include a set of commissioned reviews and we would now like to invite members of the plant evolutionary biology community to complement this review set by submitting original research manuscripts for consideration. Manuscripts must focus on some aspect of adaptation in plants. The deadline for submission is 1 February 2009 and all manuscripts will be subject to normal peer review. In the event that more manuscripts are accepted than can be included in the special issue, the Editors will determine which articles will be included; other accepted manuscripts will be published in the next available *New Phytologist* issue.
