

Very affordable full-length online thesis supplement in Acta Ophthalmologica

Acta is happy to announce that full-length theses may now be published at a very low cost as supplements to *Acta Ophthalmologica*. This makes the theses easily available throughout the world, rapidly and permanently. Thesis will be published online only, but the author will get the opportunity to obtain printed copies at a very moderate cost. A further advantage is that Wiley-Blackwell's professional staff will handle layout and production.

Acta is available online to all direct subscribers, to all members of the Nordic Ophthalmological Societies and EVER and to all libraries and institutions worldwide who have online access to the journal. Theses will be available for anyone free of charge. The nearest coming regular issue will feature a brief summary of the thesis, with reference to the full text online only version. All theses are indexed in **Medline**, and equally easy to find via PubMed as any other article.

The price for publishing a thesis up to 64 pages in length and including any number of illustrations is only $\[\in \] 2,000$. Authors are free to produce printed copies of the theses locally using the PDF file that can be supplied free of charge. Alternatively, Wiley-Blackwell can supply printed copies at only $\[\in \] 2.50$ per copy, providing an order for a minimum quantity of 200 copies is placed. An additional $\[\in \] 216$ will be added to the total cost of printed copies per colour page of the final supplement. Acta's usual free colour offer for member- and personal subscribers does not apply to thesis publication.

Production time will be approximately 8-10 weeks from the Editor-in-Chief's approval to final publication. All material published in *Acta Ophthalmologica* is subject to the approval of the Editor-in-Chief. This should normally be a rapid and easy process, if the thesis has been accepted for presentation at a University.

The production procedure of a supplement is as follows:

- 1) Wiley-Blackwell confirms receipt and contacts you for confirmation of order
- 2) Wiley-Blackwell sends manuscript to Editor for approval
- 3) Files are sent to production

4) You are contacted by Wiley-Blackwell's production office for further procedures

Please send your material electronically to jko@wiley.com In addition to the thesis material, please include a brief summary of maximum one printed Acta page. One printed page contains about 7,000 letters, space between words included. In the summary, the author should cite the main references only.
