The appointment will be for three years in the first instance, although this could be extended at nasen's discretion.

A fee of £5800 per annum will be paid on a freelance basis. BJSE is produced four times per year. You will be responsible to nasen, nasen's Editorial Board and work closely with Wiley-Blackwell who publish the journal worldwide.

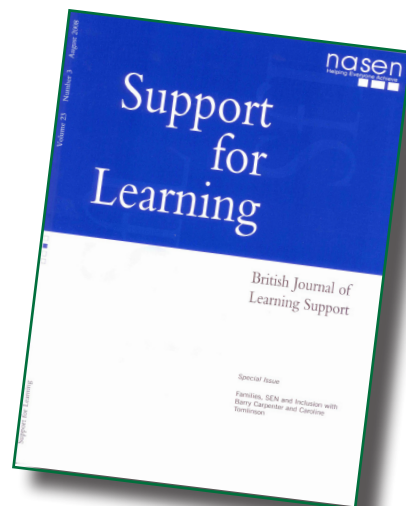
Reasonable expenses outlined as part of the production budget will also be reimbursed.
