Please follow the content suggestions and guidelines below:

- Describe the nature, content, scope and purpose of the book and its place in the relevant literature.
- Analyze the function, use and content of the book. Shortcomings of the book should be appropriately and clearly noted.
- Critically and thoughtfully evaluate the success of the book regarding its stated goals and its contribution to the field.
- Avoid a detailed description of the book's content and lengthy quotations from the book.
- The review should be 800 to 1,000 words.
- The header should include the following information:
Title. Author(s). Location: Publisher, Year of Publication. Pages, Information on diagrams, tables, references, index. Price. ISBN #.
