

APPOINTMENT OF EDITOR-IN-CHIEF [OF THE INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF PAEDIATRIC DENTISTRY]

Professor Göran Dahllöf, the current editor-in-chief of the International Journal of Paediatric Dentistry, is stepping down at the end of 2010. A search committee representing the three owners of the journal (Wiley-Blackwell, the British Society of Paediatric Dentistry and the International Association of Paediatric Dentistry) is looking for a successor.

The chosen candidate will combine a serious research reputation with commitment to clinical work in paediatric dentistry. The post is not suitable for someone close to retirement or already retired. He or she will be expected to continue the innovative work, which has marked Professor Dahllöf's time as editor-in-chief. It is also expected that he or she has experience in reviewing and/or editing scientific manuscripts, and/or serving on journal editorial boards. The new editor-in-chief will need to make available the time to organise the reviewing of papers, the other editorial processes and the framing of editorial policy. Full electronic back-up from the offices of Wiley-Blackwell in Oxford is available and there is also a modest remuneration. The individual appointed is required to be or to become a member of both the Society and the Association and to work closely with both organisations and the associate editors appointed to work with him or her.

They should consist of autobiographical information appropriate to the post in question and a statement of how the candidate's vision for the journal. The deadline for the receipt of applications is the end of January 2010.
