New Online Journals Pricing Structure for 2003

We are pleased to announce that for 2003 Blackwell Publishing has introduced a unified price structure for the majority of our journal titles. This new price structure applies to former Blackwell Publishers, Blackwell Science, Blackwell Verlag, Munksgaard and Futura journals.

Following is a summary of the new 3-tiered pricing structure. 1) Premium Subscription - print with extended online access

All Blackwell Publishing standard journal subscriptions can be 'topped up' to include PREMIUM online access for an additional 10%. PREMIUM access includes all of the advantages of the Blackwell Publishing Site License (<u>http://www.blacksci.co.uk/license</u>) and access would be via *Blackwell Synergy* or other third party services.

PREMIUM access includes:

- Access to PDF and HTML full-text articles from *current content and all available online backfiles*, dating from 1997/98 in most cases;
- Archival access to paid-for content;
- Access to *OnlineEarly articles* where available, ie. peer-reviewed articles published online before the print issue is completed;
- IP and/or remote user access authentication;
- Free electronic course pack use;
- Inter-library loan (printed from electronic copy);
- Walk-in users.

2) Standard Subscription - print with standard online access

All institutions subscribing to Blackwell Publishing print journals are now entitled to STANDARD access to the online version through *Blackwell Synergy* or other third party services.

STANDARD access includes:

- Access to PDF and HTML full-text articles for the *current and previous subscription years*;
- Access authentication by IP address;
- Customers wishing to activate this access must contact us and adhere to our click-through terms and conditions (soon to be posted on our website).

3) Online Only Subscription

The majority of Blackwell Publishing journals that have an online version available can be bought at the discounted fee of 90% of the standard subscription price. Access is at the PREMIUM level through *Blackwell Synergy* or other third party services. Institutions subscribing to Blackwell Publishing online only journals must sign the Blackwell Publishing Site License (http://www.blacksci.co.uk/license).

Consortia Purchasing Options

We continue to offer a range of purchasing options for online journals designed to meet the needs of libraries and library consortia. Access to these options is at the PREMIUM level outlined above.

a) Choice:

Purchase of individual online only journals, with discounts offered for larger quantities.

b) Subject Bundles:

Libraries may purchase a 'subject bundle' of online journals. This represents the best option for specialized institutions focusing on a defined research area, or for libraries wishing to transfer their subscriptions from print to online only.

c) Collection:

One-year deal for consortia wishing to access our entire online journals collection. This represents the best value for money enabling libraries to access over 600 of the most highly cited, peer-reviewed journals published on behalf of scholarly societies. The complete collection is ideal for multidisciplinary universities wishing to maximize online journals access for a fraction of the price whilst maintaining their print holdings or by transferring their print holdings into online only subscriptions.

The collections available in 2003 include:

- Full Blackwell Publishing Collection (including the STM and HSS Collections)
- Science, Technical and Medical Collection (STM Collection)
- Humanities and Social Science Collection (HSS Collection)

OnlineEarly – publishing peer-reviewed research even faster

We are delighted to announce the launch of an exciting new feature on *Blackwell Synergy*.

OnlineEarly allows access to fully completed, peer-reviewed articles online *before* the print issue is published, and before the issue and page numbers have even been assigned.


Print issues can sometimes take several months to put together, delaying the publication of important research. *OnlineEarly* means that faculty members and students will get access to the latest peer-reviewed articles in these leading journals much faster, without having to wait for delivery of the entire issue.

All *OnlineEarly* articles can be cited using the Digital Object Identifier (DOI), which also continues to allow links to the article even when it has been assigned to an issue. This is not a preprint service as *OnlineEarly* articles are in their final peer-reviewed and corrected form.

All visitors to the *Blackwell Synergy* site can browse through *OnlineEarly* article abstracts for free. The full-text of *OnlineEarly* articles are only available to customers with a Premium or Online Only subscription to the journal, to Collection customers, and to single article purchasers.

Draft 1 of the COUNTER Usage Reports is now available and librarians are invited to participate in an online survey that will collect your comments on the reports. The online survey and the full text of the Usage Reports is accessible via the COUNTER web site: <u>http://www.ProjectCounter.org</u>

If you haven't had a chance to fill this out yet, it only takes 20 minutes or so and it will allow you to have a direct input into what will become the industry standard suite of consistent usage reports.

Release 1 of the Code of Practice will be available at the end of 2002. An organizational framework for implementation and compliance will also be proposed at that time.
